## **PILOT - Greengrocery vouchers**

We received a generous financial donation for the work of the Foodbank and decided to use the money to pilot giving £5 green grocery vouchers to clients with children. These are given to clients when they collect a food parcel at a distribution centre and can be taken to Hamiltons in Cross Keys to exchange for fruit and vegetables. These have been well received by clients and volunteers are really positive about this development in the work of the Foodbank.


We run this with an appointment system once every two weeks, on Friday mornings at St Mary's, Eaton Socon.


