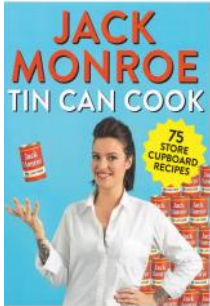

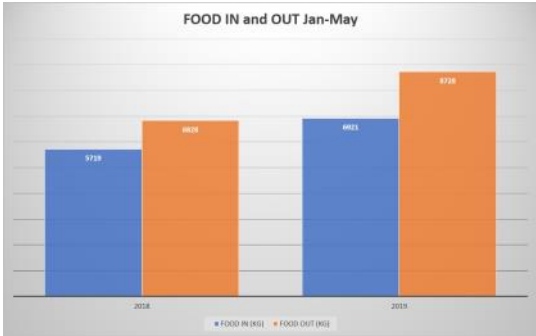
Green Grocery Voucher Scheme
