





We are currently keeping to our delivery model and still able to signpost people, where appropriate, to support available from other agencies to check people are getting the benefits they are entitled to and any savings they can make as well as dealing with wider issues affecting them and their families.






We have been helped enormously by having our own CA worker to refer people to and have not seen as many people returning frequently to the foodbank. Our aim is to make sure people are getting the correct benefits and can look at ways to manage their finances in a way that doesn't require long term use of the foodbank.



100+ HDC grants for supermarket and energy vouchers given out so far.



We have also joined the offer from Vodafone to give preloaded Sim cards to those who need them. They have 20GB data a month and unlimited phone calls and texts and last for 6 months.


